Section 1: Technology and Equipment

REQUIRED

- Computer (PC or Apple)
- Broadband internet access (preferably wired)*
- Google Chrome web browser
- Webcam
- Headset with microphone or speakers and a microphone
- Keyboard
- A strong, consistent internet connection to stream audio and video in both directions
- Ability to see the full screen and access a keyboard at the same time
- Use of microphone and camera for the duration of the course

PROHIBITED

Login from a phone or other small device

Section 2: Environment

Requirement to take the course from a quiet environment

Section 3: Engagement and Attendance

- 90% attendance policy requirement; no course credit awarded if 90% is not met, even due to connectivity issues
- Requirement to connect at least 10 minutes prior to the start of each class session
- Requirement to reply to all prompts and quizzes during the session to receive credit
- Agreement not to disconnect from room during breaks
- Requirement to close other programs / apps while class is in session

RECOMMENDED

• Wired connection (as opposed to wifi)
